Please read the user instruction leaflet carefully before you start using Efemia. Efemia should be placed like a tampon (aiming towards your lower back, not straight up). The two support rings should sit above the narrow vaginal opening, above the pelvic floor muscle, and the handle should rest against the body, inside the outer labia.

Three sizes (30, 35 and 40 mm) of Efemia Bladder Support are included in the starter set. We recommend that you experiment to establish the best (effective and comfortable) size and placement at home first. If it feels uncomfortable, or you don't get the results you aim for, you might have placed Efemia too far out or you might have the wrong size. It may take a few tries before you find out how to place Efemia comfortably. Practice makes perfect.

Efemia can be used all day up to 16 hours, or as needed throughout the day. Unit Lifespan is 3 months on average.
